REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Lakewood Township Municipal Utilities Authority (Authority) hereby solicits proposals for **the furnishing of a rental standby generator for the County Line Manor sewage lift station.**

Sealed proposals must be submitted to the Executive Director on or before March 28, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. Proposals may be submitted in person at the Authority's office located at 390 New Hampshire Ave., Lakewood, NJ, or sealed proposals may be **mailed in advance to the attention of Justin Flancbaum**, **Executive Director, 390 New Hampshire Ave., Lakewood, NJ 08701.** All proposals must be contained in a sealed envelope with the name and address of the party submitting the proposal and marked "sealed proposal."

Proposals for the below listed services are being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A.19:44A-20.5 et. seq. The following criteria will be used in the awarding of contracts for services:

- 1. Experience and knowledge in the field.
- 2. Availability to attend any meetings of the LTMUA and to service the needs of the Authority as requested by the Commissioners, Executive Director and staff.
- 3. Compensation proposal.
- 4. Any other factors deemed to be in the best interest of the Authority as detailed in the scope of services below.

In addition, the LTMUA reserves the right to consider the following other factors:

- 1. Does the vendor's proposal indicate a clear understanding of the scope of work and related objectives?
- 2. Is the vendor's proposal complete and responsive to the public notice and specifications?
- 3. Does the vendor have a record of honesty and moral integrity?
- 4. Does the vendor have a record of reliability?
- 5. Vendor's past performance to the Authority, and willingness to document same.
- 6. Vendor's past performance of similar services, and willingness to document same.

7. Does the vendor have an experienced, qualified staff to assist him in completing the Authority's assignments?

8. Are the vendor's resources, i.e. personnel, facilities etc. in reasonable proximity to Lakewood, New Jersey?

9. Will the vendor provide a timely, fully explained billing for his goods/services, including a comprehensive breakdown of specific tasks?10. Is the vendor financially stable and strong?

Scope of Service:

Vendor shall provide all necessary labor, material, & products to complete the following work:

- The furnishing of the generator is for a long term rental (possibly 1-2 years) and must be quoted on a yearly rental basis with a price per month. Contract will be on month to month basis.
- The generator will be of the trailer based type and the vendor must provide delivery and pick up to the user site.
- The size of the generator will be 65 KW and diesel powered along with a sound attenuated enclosure.
- A service rated outdoor (enclosure type) automatic transfer switch rated at 260 amps will be provided along with its connectivity to the generator. Connections from the utility power and the load to the ATS will be completed by the Authority's electrical contractor.
- It will be the generator provider's responsibility to connect the emergency power line of the ATS to the generator.
- There must be a set of contacts provided in the ATS whereas the Authority can hook up wires from and to an onsite auto dialer so that the Authority's on call personnel can be alerted when a generator run is in effect.
- The generator provider shall provide, per the generators fuel capacity, what hourly quantity of fuel the unit will burn at 50, 75 and 100% of load.
- It is understood that the Authority will be responsible for refueling.
- The generator provider must have a 24/7/365 ability to respond to an emergency breakdown and must be able to respond to such an incident with 4 hours upon receipt of the call.
- All work will be performed in accordance with LTMUA specifications.
- Contractor must be licensed and insured in the State of NJ
- A Disclosure of Investment activities in Iran must be completed and submitted together with the proposal
- A current NJ Business Registration Certificate must be submitted together with the proposal

- Contractor must be registered as a State of NJ Public works Contractor. Current registration must be submitted together with the proposal
- Contractor must be in full compliance with the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.26 et. seq.)
- Contractor must be registered with the NJ Division of Wage and Hour Compliance as required by the Public Works Contractor Registration Act (PWCRA) P.L. 1999, c.238 N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 et seq.
- In accordance with N.J.A.C. 12:60-2.1 and 6.1 of the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et. seq.) certified payroll reports must be submitted to the Authority, by all contractors and subcontractors, for each employee on the project within ten (10) days of the payment of wages.
