Water Connection Fee Hearing

March 8, 2016

I. Senator Singer opened the meeting at 2:38 P.M. in the conference room of the Lakewood Township Municipal Utilities Authority, 390 New Hampshire Avenue, Lakewood, New Jersey.

V. Water Connection Fee Hearing

The Chairman Opened the Hearing to the Public

Mr. Smith announced that the proposed rates have been made available to public. There was no response from the public.

Mrs. Lapa read **Resolution #16-41 Adoption of Water Connection Fee for 2016**. Mr. Waxman asked what the changes are. Mr. J. Flancbaum said that the Water Connection Fee went up

\$79.00 and the Sewer Connection Fee went down \$26.00. The next increase per unit is \$53.00. Mr. Waxman asked what the percentage is. The response was that the increase is in sync with inflation.
