FOR FURNISHING AND DELIVERING SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE

Sealed proposals for furnishing and delivering sodium hypochlorite to the Lakewood Township Municipal Utilities Authority will be received by the Authority at their offices at **390 New Hampshire Avenue, Lakewood, New Jersey** on or before **Tuesday November 24, 2020 at 11:00 AM** prevailing time.

Due to the Governor's declaration of a Public Health Emergency from COVID 19 proposals cannot be delivered in person. All proposals must be mailed in advance to the attention of Justin Flanbaum Executive Director, 390 New Hampshire Ave., Lakewood, NJ 08701. All proposals must be contained in a sealed envelope with the name and address of the party submitting the proposal and marked "sealed proposal."

Interested parties can participate in the bid opening by dialing (646) 838-1723 and use conference ID 785 198 934# on the date and time noted above. Contract Documents which have been prepared by the Authority and are available to prospective bidders upon request via email. Email requests for Contract Documents shall be sent to rgray@lakewoodmua.com with all supporting information including company name, contact person(s), address, phone and fax number. The Contract Documents will be furnished electronically via email at no cost to the prospective bidder. Hard copies of the bid documents will not be available or issued at this time.

Bidders shall provide two (2) firm unit prices, the 1st to furnish and deliver sodium hypochlorite for a period of one (1) year following the date of contract execution and the 2nd to furnish and deliver sodium hypochlorite for a period of two (2) years following the date of contract execution.

All bids must be completed in accordance with the requirements described in the General Requirements.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

No bid may be withdrawn for thirty (30) days following the date for receipt of the bids. The Authority reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality in any bid and to accept the bid or bids which, in its judgment, best serve the interest of the Authority. If the bid submitted does not comply with the bidding requirements at the time of the bid opening, the bid may be rejected.
